Our prominent judge grew up among various different breeds of dogs including German Shepherd Dogs, Shetland Sheepdogs, Afghan, Puli, Toy and Miniature Poodles and a Lhasa Apso.

He has also owned Shih Tzus, Whippets, Miniature Pinschers, Maltese, Dachshunds Labrador and Dobermanns. In 1984, he established Abe's Ace Dobermanns, which has gone on to become one of the most successful Dobermann homes in the Philippines.

Our revered adjudicator was once became the youngest licensed All-Breed judge in the Philippines. He is one of five (5) active All-Breed Judges in the country. He is a lifetime member of the Philippine Canine Club Inc., served as a Director for 9 years and Show Committee Chairman for eight years. He is directly responsible for the current Championship point system and the Dog of the Year system.

To date, the highlight of his judging career was being selected as the lone Asian representative to the fifteen (15) member international judges panel who judged the prestigious FCI-AKU 50th Anniversary Dog Show of the Japan Kennel Club in Tokyo of March 1999. He also judged the Dobermann breed and other breeds at the world famous Bundessieger Show in Dortmund Germany. In 2001 he judged the Dog of the Year Competition at the largest and most prestigious show in South Africa, The Goldfields Show.

He has judged in extensively in Australia, China, Germany, India, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, South Africa, Thailand the United States of America, Canada, Sweden and Norway.
